CURRENT DEVELOPMENTS

1. Inaugulation Ceremony of Zinunula Internationa Junior School.

The school was officially opened on 15th/ July/2023. The function was attended by a big number of community members, political leaders and religious leaders headed by Bishop Severus Jjumba, the Bishop of Masaka Diocese.

2. St. Benedict



- The number of pupils has increased since the renovation from 150 pupils to over 400pupils.
- The school management and Parents & Teachers' Association (PTA) managed to fund the school's Hydro Electricity as a back up in case Solar Energy is down and has also worked on the sports playground to promote sports in the school.
- The wiring of the school buildings is in progress and immediately after the completion of the wiring phase hydroelectricity is to be connected; now the school is well equipped with both hydroelectricity and solar energy.
- Currently the school management & PTA are mobilizing local contribution for the dormitories (to provide accommodation for pupils that come from long distance), more furniture (since the pupils are increasing, more chairs are needed) and the school kitchen.
