1. ST BENEDICT PRIMARY SCHOOL KIWAAWO

a) KITCHEN CONSTRUCTION.

In the past, the school's Kitchen was in a very bad condition thus not conducive for the pupils.

The school management advised on the kind of Kitchen needed for the school and through KAP, it requested for funds to finance the Kitchen project. A team of KAP friends in Germany mobilized for funds and donated it to St. Benedict School through KAP.

Kalungu District Planning department approved the site plan, the School management implemented the Kitchen construction and KAP management monitored the construction. The Kitchen building is completed and full commissioning is pending installation of energy saving stoves. The energy saving stoves are intended to be installed in August 2024.

b) SPORTS /ATHLETICS FOR UGANDA PRIMARY SCHOOLS

In May 2024, St. Benedict School engaged in athletics competitions for all Primary schools in Uganda, the competitions were organized by Uganda Primary Schools Association (UPSA) to get the best school.

The school was represented by Sselule Ivan (under 14 competitions) and Kalema Muhammad (under 12 competitions). At sub-county level St. Benedict was the best in Kyamulibwa Sub-county in both under 12 and under 14 competitions, then the school was promoted to District level.

Also at the district level St. Benedict was number one, so the school was qualified at Nationals level to compete with all schools from different districts in Uganda. The competitions at National level took place in Kitgum district. At the end of the competitions St. Benedict took the second position in under 14 and third position in under 12 in Uganda.

PROJECTS IN PIPELINE

1. BENEFICIARIES RENTAL PROJECT.

This is a project that deals in renting residential and commercial houses at affordable costs to the community members of Kyamulibwa- Kalungu district.

The income from the project supports the sponsored children with their guardians and part of the income is used to finance the organization's administration costs.

Currently KAP management is seeking for funds to execute the activities of project phase 2 and these include;

- a) Renovation of four (4) units and construction of one (1) single unit.
- b) Construction of a pit latrine with bathrooms.
- c) Installation of a water harvesting system.
